## LEADERSHIP



LEADERSHIP: the process of influencing others to accomplish a certain goal

WHY DO WE STUDY LEADERSHIP SO MUCH? A good leader is able to ACCOMPLISH important things no matter what position he or she is in. Leaders are communicators, visionaries, and role models. They inspire others to do things and make them feel part of something bigger than themselves. Leadership is important because people naturally have needs and desires, and if they don't know how to get what they want or need through proper leadership, then they often resort to not-so-very nice ways to get what they want, such as aggression or manipulation, also known as bullying. The opposite of leader is NOT a follower. The opposite of a leader is a bully.

Just because someone is "in charge" does not make them a good leader. And just because someone is a leader, it doesn't mean they are necessarily have to be in charge!

Think of someone you think of as a role model. They usually have certain qualities that you admire. You might try to be around them and become like them.

Did you know that you actually become like 5 people you associate with the most? That's right. If you think of the 5 people you interact with the most, you will probably notice you have picked up their habits or speech patterns. These 5 people do not have to be real or living people. They can be in books, videos or video games. Usually 2-3 of these people are your family members. The others might be your friends or role models. Have you chosen friends and role models with good values?

Our VALUES are the things that are most important to us. They determine how we make the choices that shape our destinies. The Niagara Kung Fu Academy Leadership Values that we study are PERSEVERANCE, COMPASSION, LEADERSHIP, INTEGRITY, COURAGE, and ACCOUNTABILITY. Some other important martial art values you might recognize are STRENGTH, KNOWLEDGE, SPIRIT, and RESPECT.

Before setting a goal, it is important to decide if the goal is in line with your values. For instance if your #1 VALUE is FAMILY, but your #1 GOAL is to be an astronaut and move to Mars, then you might have a conflict...unless the rest of your family is moving to Mars also.

We should know what we value. Our values may change from time to time as we grow into ourselves, but it is important to take stock of what you think is most important. We choose our leaders based on our values. Leaders with similar values will lead us in the direction we want to go. For example, your kung fu instructor values GOOD HEALTH, and if you also value your health, then following him or her would be a good idea.
